We are ever grateful to our heavenly Father that by His providence and blessing we could complete 37 years of ministry in India and now entering 38 years (1987-2024). We are delighted to give you a gist of our one-year activities as follows:

• KOLKATA LOVE REFORMED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (KLRPC)*

By the grace of God throughout this year we had five services on each Sunday in our KLRPC. 9 & 11AM-Bengali Service, 1 PM- Hmar, 3 PM-English, 6 PM- Hindi. Also, every day Early Morning Prayer at 6 AM, Wednesday- 7PM, Friday- 8PM, Every 3rd Friday at 11 AM Day Fasting Prayer in every month. We had celebrated our Church 37th Anniversary on March 1st at our Kolkata Mission Centre in presence of 400 people where special speaker was Rev. Griffith Umwi from Pokshe Presbyterian Church, Shillong. "Day with Jesus" was celebrated on 31st October 2024 in presence of 105 people.

• INDIA REFORMED PRESBYTERIAN THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY (IRPTS)*

By the providence of God this seminary was started in 1988 at 9A Hati Bagan Road, Kolkata -14 and afterwards shifted to Canning, 24 Parganas (S) from where approximate 280 students has been graduated B.Th and M.Div. On 2nd March our B.Th. Student Philip Gope was graduate and the Dr. Sunil Caleb (Principal of Bishop College) delivered the message in the Valedictory service and Rev. Sujoy Roy gave a congratulatory word. We are thankful to Netherland Reformed Church, EVTA, CMAI and Asian Mission for their partnership and prayer to carry the work of our seminary.

PARUL PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (Uttar Dinajpur)

This church is located near Bangladesh border and presently Evan. Dibendu Biswas serving there. There is urgent need of Door & Window Grill which may cost near about Rs. 80,000/ (US\$1000) and also need to have a guard or care taker for the campus.



4. LAKHIRPAR, RAHAGONJ, KOTALIPARA PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (BD)

It is my joy to share with you that God has helped us to plant three churches in Bangladesh by one of our graduate Rev. Shankar Hazra to Gopalgunge, Khulna and Barisal district by His grace. All these three places Rev. Hazra has baptize more than 14th believers and conducted communion services. All these three places he wants to build church with wood and tin shades which may cost each church Rs. 90,000/- please pray.

5. LOVE REFORMED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (Mymensingh, BD)

By grace of God in Bangladesh a new church has been started by George RintuRatno at Mymensingh district in Bangladesh. Myself and elder Ashis Saha was supposed to go but due to illness unable to go, but God's work doesn't stop (Acts16:7-8). Pray for the growth of the Church.

A free mobile clinic runs by Dr. Rabindra Nath Mondal with the supervision of Rev. Biswajit Halder & Mrs. Mitrani Halder, yearly 900 patients.
